Fort Lee is able to conduct on-the-spot background checks on individuals by simply scanning their military IDs, drivers' licenses or other accepted forms of state- or government-issued identification. Players and guests may access Fort Lee using any gate as long as you and all passengers in the vehicle have a valid driver's license or other accepted forms of state/government-issued identification.

PRIOR TO THE TOURNAMENT DATE: It is recommended by the security team that first-time visitors, who will use a driver's license to access the installation, visit the Visitor Control Center (Lee Gate) for the initial scan in order to "get them in the system" and avoid the potential hassle of denied access.
